## **Tools Required**

- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Nut Driver
- 10mm wrench
- 5/16" nut driver
- Pipe wrench

## **Replacement Instructions**

- 1) Turn off power and gas to the boiler.
- 2) Disconnect air intake from the venturi.
- 3) Remove wiring and tubes from combustion blower, gas valve, igniter, and flame probe.

**Deflector Insulation (Tx)** 

- 4) Remove gas line from the gas valve.
- 5) Remove burner door, gas valve, and blower as an assembly
- 6) Wet the deflector insulation to reduce the dust
- 7) Pry off the deflector insulation. (ensure all metal clips are removed prior to installing new deflector).

- 8) Do not remove the plastic covering on the deflector insulation. This will burn off when the boiler is first fired.
- 9) Line up metal clip on back of the deflector insulation with stab fitting and press evenly around the middle of the disk until fully seated.
- 10) Re-assemble in the reverse order.



Flue Gas Leakage – Failure to properly seal the burner door may result in leakage of flue gas which may lead to serious injury or death.
